## **iDiv Summer School 2020**

### **Pollination Ecology**

The German Centre for Integrative Biodiversity Research (iDiv) Halle-Jena-Leipzig in cooperation with the Helmholtz Centre for Environmental Research (UFZ) will conduct its sixth summer school “Pollination Ecology” from 6 to 11 July 2020 in Leipzig, Germany.

During the six summer school days, participants will be immersed into the field of pollination ecology with lectures, computer labs using the programming language R, fieldwork, plant and insect identification, and data analysis (Species Accumulation Curves, Linear Regression, NMDS, Network Metrics). In addition, students will have opportunities to attend iDiv Seminars and exchange with iDiv researchers. A colorful side program for social activities with a sightseeing tour of Leipzig and BBQ will be offered to allow time for networking and having fun.

The summer school aims to attract early career scientists (bachelor, master, or PhD level) from around the world with an overall interest in pollination ecology and interest in fieldwork.
