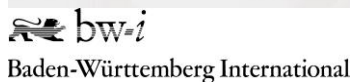

The **First International Conference in Early Childhood Education Research (ECER)** brings together engaged research and researchers in Europe and around the globe to share knowledge and action towards **Quality and Professionalisation** in this field. We especially welcome proposals on the main theme; broader topics of research in early childhood education are also welcome. The ECER-Conference seeks the development of a network within the participating international universities and offers a welcoming and safe platform for senior and junior scholars to discuss their research considering different cultural perspectives. The conference is organized in partnership with the five Universities of Education in Southern Germany, the University of Education St. Gallen (Switzerland) and supported by the 'Internationale Bodensee Hochschule (IBH)', a network of universities from Austria, Germany, Liechtenstein and Switzerland in the Lake Constance region. It is in addition supported by Baden-Württemberg International (bw-i), Agency for International Economic and Scientific Cooperation. Please find the preliminary programme attached.
